

WAYS TO FILL YOUR LOOT BAG

*Kids, make sure to get your parent or guardian's permission before taking part in any of these fundraising activities.

Have Fun with Milestones: Willing to dye your hair or shave your head if you hit a goal? How about challenging a friend or classmate with a friendly competition? These types of things make for great video content to send to your supporters or share on social media if you have it.

Give Something Up (It's for the kids!): Skip that daily Starbucks, weekly take out order or late-night impulse order on Amazon and donate the amount you would have spent to your fundraising page.

One-a-Day: Make it a goal to ask one person every day to make a donation to your fundraising page. This five minute task each day could add up to a whole lot of donations for children and families.

Donate Your Birthday: Have a birthday coming up? Instead of purchasing gifts this year, ask your family and friends to contribute towards your goal.

Snail Mail: Write handwritten cards or letters to your family and friends letting them know you're fundraising for Big Change Roundup and ask them to visit your personal fundraising page and support you in meeting your goal.

Offer Creativity: Put your craftiness to work and make some cool crafts, bake something or auction off some of your unused collectibles, all for donations. Or offer a special, homemade gift you can send as a thank you for every donation to your page.

Host an Event: Plan anything from a movie night to a swim-a-thon and ask for donations for entry.

Phone-a-Thon: Have everyone in your posse bring a list of phone numbers for friends, family members, coworkers, etc. and spend an afternoon calling individuals and encouraging them to make a donation to your fundraising page. You can even make it a competition to see who can make the most calls in a certain amount of time and who raises the most from those calls.
